**Field Trial Dogs (and Bitches)** class shall be for dogs and bitches which have placed at an AKC licensed or Member Field Trial, or Hunt Test or who have been awarded a WCA Field or Water Retrieving prior to the closing date of the show. (Divided by Sex)

**Versatile/Versatile Excellent Dogs (and Bitches)** class shall be open to dogs and bitches who have been awarded a Versatile or Versatile Excellent rating from the Weimaraner Club of America prior to the closing date of the show. (Divided by Sex)

## **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

**Judge: Ms. Charlene Troast**

### **Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)**

**Stud Dog Class** will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. An entry fee of \$30.00 will be charged for each Stud Dog if he is not entered in any Regular class, Best of Breed Competition or other Non-Regular Class. If he is entered in another class the fee is \$15.00 and should be indicated in the "Additional Class" space of the entry form. The Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or another Non-Regular Class and need not pay a fee for being shown in the Stud Dog class as Get.

**Brood Bitch Class** will be for Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. Produce only to be judged based on the merits of the Produce. An entry fee of \$30.00 will be charged for each Brood Bitch if she is not entered in any Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or other Non-Regular Class. If she is entered in another class the fee is \$15.00 and should be indicated in the "Additional Class" space of the entry form. The Produce must be entered in another class and need not pay a fee for being shown in the Brood Bitch Class as Produce.

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

## **SWEEPSTAKES**

**JUDGE: Ms. Denise Reel**

The Sweepstakes is open to all Weimaraner Dogs and Bitches 6 months of age and under 24 months of age on the day of the Show. An entry fee of \$15.00 must accompany the regular entry fee. The Garden State Weimaraner Club will retain 35% of the entry fee in order to defray expenses. All Sweepstakes entries must be entered in Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. Entry blank should have "Sweepstakes" entered in the "Additional Classes" space.

In addition, there will be Veteran Sweepstakes classes consisting of Dogs at least 7 yrs of age and less than 9 years on the day of the show, 9 years and under 11 years, and 11 years and older with the same classes for Bitches. All winners will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes. Same fee requirements as for puppies. Spayed and neutered Dogs and Bitches are eligible to compete in Veteran Sweepstakes and need not be entered in Regular Breed classes.

### **From Route 287**

**Southbound:** follow Rte 287 South to Exit 17 (Somerville/Rte 202/206). When the road splits, take Rte 202 So. Approx. 2 miles down Rte 202 you will travel under a train overpass. Make a Right onto Milltown Rd., travel approx. ½ mi. to Park on left.

**Northbound:** follow Rte 287 No to Rte 22 West. Follow Rte 22 West directions below.

### **From Rte. 22:**

**Westbound:** follow Rte 22 West to Rte 202/206 South. After ½ mile the highway will split. Take Rte 202 So. Approx. 2 miles down Rte 202 you will travel under a train overpass. Make a Right onto Milltown Rd., travel approx. ½ mi. to Park on left.

**Eastbound:** follow Rte 22 East through Branchburg. Make Right onto Milltown Rd. Follow Milltown Rd to Park on left.

### **From Rte 206:**

**Northbound:** Follow Rte 206 until Somerville Circle. Exit off the circle onto Rte 202 South. Approx. 2 miles down Rte 202

You will travel under a train overpass. Make Right onto Milltown Road, follow approx. ½ mi. to Park on left.

### **From Rte 78:**

**Westbound:** Follow Rte 78 W to Rte. 287 South. Follow directions above.

**Eastbound:** Follow Rte 78 East to Rte 22 East. Follow directions above.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRY FEE: \$30 .00 for the first entry of each dog including \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event fee. \$15.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. \$ 15.00 for a Sweepstakes Entry. \$30.00 Obedience Entry. \$30.00 entry for Non-Regular entry.

CLOSING DATE for entries: 5:00 PM, Wednesday, **September 22, 2010** at Show Secretary's home, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

THE SHOW AND OBEDIENCE TRIAL: will be open from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM

A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 will be required for each dog entered in any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. The Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever shall make such errors and no entry fee shall be refunded in event such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING SCHEDULE FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CASH CLASS PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary is to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and the Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARK PER PARK COMMISSION REGULATIONS

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### AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient, in consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies. I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

**Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole, responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents or any other persons. I(WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE ALLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

### INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 12 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles). Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a champion.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
