Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf Most important to note are the following:

- 1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. Routes to the Show

The event grounds are located on Milltown Rd., North Branch, (Bridgewater Township) New Jersey. Milltown Rd. runs between US 202 and US 22. Major State and Federal highways provide easy access to these events.

From Route 287

Southbound: NY I-87 and NJ I-80 to Route 287 South to Exit 17 (Somerville/Rte. 202/206 South). When the highways split take Route 202 South. Approximately two miles down Route 202, you will travel under a train overpass. Make a right at the next turn onto Milltown Rd. Travel a half mile, and North Branch Park will be on the left.

Northbound: NJ Turnpike or Garden State Parkway to Route 287 North to Route 22 West. Follow the Route 22 West directions below.

From Route 22

Westbound: Follow Route 22 West to Route 202/206 South. After a half mile, the highways split. Take Route 202 South. Approximately 2 mile down Route 202, you will then travel under a train overpass. Make a right at the next turn onto Milltown Rd. Travel a half mile, and North Branch Park will be on the left.

Eastbound: Follow Route 22 East through Branchburg. Make a right turn onto Milltown Rd. Follow Milltown Rd. for 1 mile and bear right under the railroad trestle. North Branch Park will be on the right. - Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
